The 4th & 5th Rounds of British Cobra Cup Challenge, Rounds 5 & 6 of GP-Pro Series & R8 & R9 Summer Championship was held at the fantastic GP Foxhills circuit.

Both days of the British Cobra Cup Challenge with another excellent entry of 32 riders was dominated by Daniel Breen who took all six wins over the weekend. Once again it was Lewis Townsend who two both days runners up spot with Tyler Rowe third on the Saturday and Jack Clarke on the Sunday. A mention for Charlie Burt, Finley Beard who took top three placing but crashes placed them down the order and Billy Wilson who took a race third.

The Juniors 65 class was very fast and with the inclusion of a famous hill, which the whole class mastered, was dominated by the countries fabled national riders. Albie Wilkie took the two days honours followed by Ryan Vickers and Drew Warren. Albie Wilkie took 5 race wins over the weekend showing his bravery on the jumps however a first race fall spoilt total domination. Ryan Vickers on top form and push Albie all the way with a race win and five second places meant it was always going to be tight going into the last race. Drew Warren with consistent good places took third overall with two thirds a fourth and three fifths. A mention for Taylor Hammal who took three thirds on day two but didn't ride on the Saturday and Nathan Harlow with a race third.

In the Small Wheels class it was Joe Jefferies who took all six race wins for the second maximum of the weekend. Jack Seabourne took runners up spot over the weekend with two seconds and a third in his tally. Third overall as Dylan Hodgkins with a race third and consistent riding. Danny Mell took two second places on the Saturday but a seized engine ruined what would have been a good weekend. Josh Coleman took two race seconds and a third on the Sunday but didn't race the Saturday leaving him absent from the overalls.

The Big Wheels saw Rob Davidson took the top spot over the weekend with four race wins and two seconds exactly the same score card at the last two days. Ben Cole took an excellent weekend runners up spot with a second and two thirds on his scorecard. In third overall was Chubbie Hammond with two second places in his tally.
